I was so proud of the Head/Deputy pupils and Prefects who helped serve parents and politely asked them for feedback on what was going well and what we could focus on as a school. On my learning walk this week, Year 5 have had the Fire Service deliver a workshop, learning how to stay safe in case there was a fire and what to do. The Fire Service were very complimentary on their listening skills and contributions.
