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Remote Learning for all pupils

- Pupils in Reception will have a Monday 'live' introduction session and 'live' Friday summary session. Prerecorded sessions and additional 'live' sessions will also occur during the week.
- Reception/KS1 –Liam will be delivering daily Zoom PE sessions at 9.00-9.30 am.
- All pupils in KS1 and KS2 will have at least 2 daily 'live or pre-recorded' sessions.
- KS2 –Liam will be delivering daily Zoom PE sessions 9.35-10.05 am.
- Teachers will check on pupils on a weekly basis and provide feedback to engagement.

Free School Meals

• **Currently,** the Government are stating that the food packages are to be provided to pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium. If you are in receipt of Pupil Premium and require a lunch made, please email the <u>office@hamsey.surrey.sch.uk</u> for this week. Unfortunately, a voucher alternative is not currently available. This guidance may well change.

Meals will need to be collected (socially distanced) at 11.30am from the dining hall (via the slope.)

• If your child is **IN** school and in receipt of Pupil Premium or in Rec/Yr 1 or Yr 2 (under the Universal Free School Meal Scheme) they will still receive their free school meal in school. Please let us know if we are not already aware of dietary needs if you choose a hot meal for your child. These will need to be booked in the usual way.
