The number of key worker families across the Trust remains small and because of this we have taken the DfE and Surrey Local Authority advice and retained our hub school approach for the next three weeks. During these exceptional times, we are very aware that the financial circumstances of many families may have significantly changed and it might be that many more families are now eligible for free school meals, even in the short term.
