This week in school and nursery, we have been celebrating Feeling Good Week. This event helps teach the children the importance of looking after their own and other people's physical, mental and emotional health. By encouraging our children to work together, build relationships, developing greater empathy and understanding, will help them to positively share how they're feeling and being able to share experiences with others can help encourage positive mental health. Good mental health helps children and young people to develop resilience, which can help them to cope with experiences they may encounter. This is why the resilience value is a very important value to teach. The children have designed posters, discussed who they trust to share their thoughts and feelings with; some have participated in yoga and mindful activities to relieve anxiety.



Our Feeling Good Week began with more exciting baby news-Miss Bishop has had a gorgeous baby boy, named Louis! Mum and baby are well and we look forward to seeing them both! Our week will be ending with baby Harper snuggles as Mr Boffa is going to bring his daughter in to visit us.... Now I just need to find a puppy to cuddle and my week will be content!



On Tuesday, our Year 4's ventured back in time, visiting Butser Ancient Farm, where they learnt more about Celtic and Romans life. They particularly enjoyed the jewellery making, chalk scraping and archaeology dig! We were extremely proud of their behaviour, working together and resilience skills when learning some very tricky skills. On Thursday, Year 5 learnt vital first aid skills. 16th October is Restart a Heart Day which raises awareness about cardiac arrest, helps people to learn CPR, gives them life saving skills and the confidence to use them. We were so proud of them as they listened so well to the medics, practiced CPR and learnt how to put someone in the recovery position.

Healthy Snacks & Lunchbox

P2/P

Bring **WATER** everyday!

Putting tap water in a reusable bottle is FREE and will help keep your child hydrated all day!



Whole Grains

(Great for Snack or Lunch)

Make sandwiches with whole grain bread. Look for labels that say "100% Whole Grain"

Pack healthy snacks each day. Add a healthy sweet or savory treat. Try whole grain crackers and pretzels for savory snacks or dried fruits for sweet treats.

Snacks
