#### Dear Parents & Carers,

This week, staff have been implementing their new writing lessons with the children following our INSET. I have had the pleasure of walking around the school, observing lessons and listening to children's conversations with all of you about their learning. Across the school I have seen the children learning a model text with actions; hopefully you might see these appear at home. ## **COVID** testing

Schools are being encouraged to ask their community to continue to regularly test using lateral flow tests. They can be ordered online here.

If you have secondary school aged children: Based on recent UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA, formally PHE) advice. We have been advised to encourage students or staff identified as contacts in secondary schools to also test daily on a lateral flow device until they receive their PCR test result.
