Dear All

This week, we have linked Internet Safety Day learning on how to stay safe online to Children's Mental Health Week. This is a National Week, which takes place February 7-13. This years' theme is on Growing Together which is about growing emotionally and finding ways to help each other to grow. The children have been learning that challenges and setbacks can help us to grow and that sometimes we need to adapt and try new things which can help us to move beyond our comfort zone into a new realm of possibility and potential. However, emotional growth is often a gradual process that happens over time and sometimes we might feel a bit 'stuck'. Recognising that it is OK to ask for help and so the children have been discussing who their support bubbles are, learning about emotional resilience and learnt some tips to help regulate their emotions. Year 6 children have presented in assembly on recognising different emotions, how people can react differently and have designed posters on 'how the looks we give could be perceived by others.' Year 4 were really engaged in their water workshop by an SES water employee. She spoke to the children about where our water comes from and how it is treated to make it safe for use. She also

spoke to the children about ways to save water and gave them some tips to try at home which included giving them a small sand timer to take home to time their showers. She set them a challenge of reducing their shower down to four minutes—I wonder how many minutes they do spend in the shower?!

As you know, today is an INSET day for Talk for Writing across both the School and Nursery; so we wish you a happy additional day off and we look forward to seeing you on

COVID testing

Schools are being encouraged to ask their community to continue to regularly test using lateral flow tests. They can be ordered online here.

NEW – Half Term advice for staff and families

Please continue to promote the protective messages with staff and families.

COVID rates remain high, and the best ways to protect yourself, and others, is by washing your hands, letting the fresh air in, cleaning, wearing a face covering in crowded and enclosed spaces, testing regularly and getting vaccinated; it is particularly important during the half term holiday to be aware of protecting yourself and others when mixing with people that you do not usually meet with.

REMINDER – Current Isolation periods

We continue to receive queries regarding isolation periods. Whilst it is important that the full guidance is read, as summarised extracts are easily taken out of context and there are often important caveats, we hope that the summary of recommendations below will be helpful:

- The early 'test to release' option (negative LFD tests on days 5 and 6, 24 hours apart) for **positive COVID 19 cases** applies regardless of vaccine status.
- Unvaccinated **COVID 19 contacts** of cases are required to self-isolate for the full 10-day period.
- Fully vaccinated individuals who are **COVID 19 contacts** don't need to isolate but should take daily LFD tests for 7 days.
